ENTRY FEES	There will be no entry fee for the Prime Lamb Carcass competition.
DELIVERY OF ENTRIES	Lamb/s to be delivered to Warwick Saleyards before 12 noon on Wednesday, 29 <sup>th</sup> January, 2025.
PRIZE MONEY and/or PRIZES	Winners share \$300 in prize money Trophy - Champion Lamb Carcass
VIEWING	Prize winners will be on display in the refrigerated glass showcase in the Sheep and Wool pavilion during the show.

Gate admission fees apply on Friday & Saturday. Stanthorpe Agricultural Society members free.

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. National Vendor Declaration made out to Stanthorpe Show Lambs c/o Carey Bros.
- 2. Preliminary judging of the lambs will occur on the hoof at the saleyards with the best ten selected for the carcass competition. Judging of the carcasses will take place at the Stanthorpe Sheep and Wool Pavillion on the Friday morning of the show.
- 3. The remaining lambs will be sold at the weekly Sheep and Lamb Sale through KP McMahon and Sons or the exhibitors nominated agent.
- 4. Lambs will be slaughtered at *Carey Bros* Abattoir, Yangan, co-sponsors of the Prime Lamb Carcass Competition. *Carey Bros* have donated \$250 prize money for this competition.
- 5. Overweight and underweight carcasses will be penalised. Overweight carcasses will have one point deducted for each kg by which they exceed 26kg. Underweight carcasses will have one point deducted for each kg under 18kg.
- 6. At current market prices lamb carcasses will be purchased by *Stanthorpe Quality Meats*, cosponsors of the competition. *Stanthorpe Quality Meats* have donated \$50 prize money.
- 7. Lambs become the property of the Stanthorpe Agricultural Society upon consignment to the abattoir.
