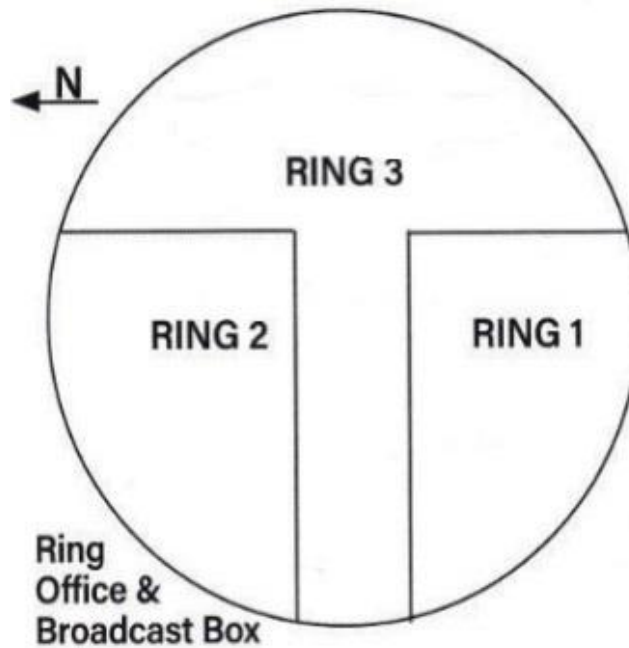

- All horses and ponies in height classes must be measured.

## HELMETS

- All competitors are reminded that helmets must be worn in all classes and anytime while riding on the grounds.
- **Helmets must be tagged when competing in any classes.**
