

HORSE STALLS

HORSE MEASURING TIMES

- All horses and ponies in height classes must be measured.
- Horse measuring times are 7.30am to 9.00am Fri and Sat at measuring slab near exercise ring.
- A measuring certificate from any Royal Show or Hack Council Queensland will be accepted.

HELMETS

- All competitors are reminded that helmets must be worn in all classes and anytime while riding on the grounds.
- Helmets must be tagged when competing in any classes.

- Classes will not be delayed. Competitors must report to Marshalling steward within three minutes of first call. In case of events clashing competitor must decide.
