

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY - IMPORTANT FOR ALL CLASSES

- 1. One entry per person per class.
- 2. Rookie Classes are for exhibitors who have not previously won a prize in that class at a Stanthorpe Show.
- 3. Young Adult Cooks, 15yrs+ wishing to enter the cookery section are directed to enter the Adult Rookie or Open classes.
- 4. Unless otherwise shown, prize value is 1st \$10.00, 2nd \$5.00.
- 5. Cookery entries must be **PRESENTED ON RIGID BOARDS OR STRONG DISPOSABLE PLATES**. We suggest placing feet under rigid boards for ease of handling. Please make sure the plate size is appropriate for the size of your exhibit disposable plates are preferred. Only entries in classes K2-K8 will be clingwrapped.
- 6. Judges' decisions are final and judges reserve the right not to award prizes.
- 7. Prizes and exhibits are to be collected on Sunday 2/2/23 between 9.00am 11.30am. Any exhibits not collected will be disposed of after 12.00pm 2/2/23.
- 8. Uncollected prizes will be held by Cookery subcommittee (see above) and if not claimed WITHIN THREE MONTHS will become a donation to the Stanthorpe Agricultural Society Inc. Prizes will not be mailed.

ADDITIONAL NOTES FOR ICED DECORATED CAKES AND SUGAR ARTISTRY CLASSES

- 1. Because these exhibits, in the shape of a cake or sculpture, are judged only on the application and design of the decoration, it is <u>preferred</u> that 'cake or sculpture shaped' dummies be used as the basis to show the design and application skills. These entries do not require a baked cake as the foundation as there is no cutting or tasting.
- 2. You can use a commercial Styrofoam cake shape, create one yourself or even use a shoebox! Whatever you feel will show your artistry off to the best advantage. This will also save money and time as no cake making or cooking is involved and it is lighter to carry.
- 3. The dummy used, and the design of the shape must be such that the design would hold together if in fact cake had been used. Shapes such as an upright circle are not permitted as it would collapse if actual cake had been used. This condition will apply to shapes and sculptures using both Fondant and Buttercream.
- 4. If you wish to obtain specific shapes/sizes, check out Granite Belt Cleaning and Hospitality for assistance or search online for suppliers.
- 5. The <u>Sugar or Chocolate Artistry</u> categories **are for exhibits that are not cakes**. You may wish to create a floral arrangement, vase, an everyday household item or an individual artwork or scene, the choice is both boundless and yours!
- 6. Please present items in all classes on rigid boards with feet.
- 7. Judging is by visual inspection; entries are not physically handled or tasted.

The exhibit is to be presented on a base board no wider than 15cm.
