- 6. Stewards will have the power to reject any diseased or unpresentable birds from the Show.
- 7. Entries close 24 January 2024 and all entries must be on the general entry form.
- 8. Any person who conducts themselves in an objectionable manner will be asked to leave the pavilion.
- 9. Judging will be open to the public and will commence at 9.30am.
